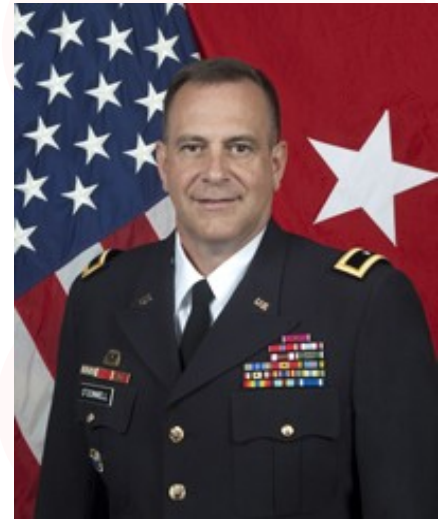

**Presenting the PACOM J-4 Organization, and mission in addition to
their part of the recent Japanese relief effort, Operation Tomodachi**

Brigadier General O'Connell was born in Washington, DC and raised in nearby Clinton, Maryland. He was commissioned as an Officer in the Quartermaster Corps, through Army ROTC at High Point College, High Point, North Carolina in 1982.

After commissioning, he was assigned to the 21st Support Command, Kaiserslautern, Germany, where he served as the Logistics Officer, 90th Personnel and Administration Battalion, and Platoon Leader in the 593d Supply and Service and 5th Maintenance Companies, in the 66th Maintenance Battalion, 29th Area Support Group.

As a Captain, he was assigned to the 13th Support Command, Fort Hood, Texas, where he served as the Operations Officer, 553d Supply and Service Battalion. He later commanded the 289th General Supply Company, 553d Supply and Service Battalion. Following command, he was assigned to the Fifth US Army, Fort Sam Houston, Texas where he served in the Inspector General's Office and later as the Aide-de-Camp to the Commanding General.

As a Colonel, he returned to Germany to assume command of the 1st Infantry Division Support Command in Kitzingen, Germany, which later reorganized to the 1st Sustainment Brigade at Fort Riley, Kansas, and deployed to Taji, Iraq in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. Following Command, he was assigned as Special Assistant and then Executive Officer to the Commanding General, US Army Materiel Command.

He deployed the Task Force Eagle Materiel Management Team to Lukavac, Bosnia, supporting Operation Joint Endeavor, and subsequently was assigned as the Support Operations Officer, 123d Main Support Battalion, Division Support Command, 1st Armored Division, in Lukavac, Bosnia; Slavonski Brod, Croatia; and Dexheim, Germany. For his final duty with the 1st Armored Division, he served as the Chief, Division Materiel Management Center, in Bad Kreuznach, Germany.

He followed his assignments in Germany serving as Chief, Supply and Services Branch, Logistics Resources Division, J-4, United States Pacific Command, Camp H.M. Smith, Hawaii.
