**Brigadier General Joe Bass, USA, Commanding General, U.S. Army Expeditionary Contracting Command**

Brigadier General Joe Bass is the Commanding General of the Expeditionary Contracting Command, a subordinate command to the Army Contracting Command that provides effective and agile expeditionary contracting across the full spectrum of military operations for Army service component commands and the joint Warfighter, and provides effective and responsive contracting support to the Army and other federal agencies at Army installations outside of the continental United States.

His previous assignment was as the Acting Deputy Director, U.S. Army Contracting Command. He also served as ACC’s Chief of Staff prior to becoming the Deputy Director.

Colonel (Promotable) Bass entered the Army in 1983 as a Distinguished Military Graduate through the Reserve Officers Training Corps program at Longwood University in Farmville, Virginia, and was commissioned in the Quartermaster Corps.

He has held numerous command and staff positions during his 28 years in the Army. Early in his career he served in logistical command and staff positions and was assigned to troop units at Fort Bragg, Belgium, and Germany, including serving as the Commander, 5<sup>th</sup> Quartermaster Detachment (Air Delivery), Kaiserslautern, Germany.

He has a Master of Arts Degree in Management from Webster University, St. Louis, Missouri, and a Master of Science Degree in National Resource Strategy from the National Defense University, Fort McNair, Washington, D.C.
